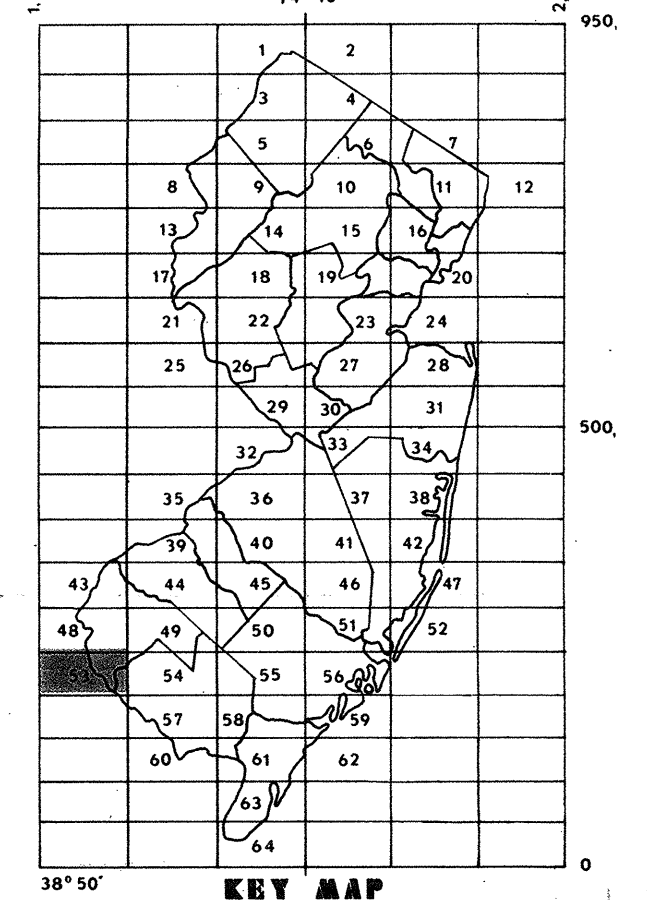


NOTE:
 WITHIN THE TWELVE MILE CIRCLE ABOUT THE TOWN OF NEW CASTLE, DELAWARE, THE RIVER AND THE SUBAQUEOUS SOIL THEREOF UP TO THE LOW WATER MARK ON THE EASTERLY OR NEW JERSEY SIDE WILL BE ADJUDGED TO BELONG TO THE STATE OF DELAWARE SUBJECT TO THE COMPACT OF 1905.
 BELOW THE TWELVE MILE CIRCLE THE TRUE BOUNDARY WILL BE ADJUDGED TO BE THE MIDDLE OF THE MAIN SHIP CHANNEL IN DELAWARE RIVER AND BAY.
