**Purpose of Meeting**

The purpose of the briefing was to provide residents with information on anticipated improvements and construction staging information for I-295 from Route 45 (Exit 24) in Gloucester County to Haddonfield-Berlin Road (Exit 32) in Camden County. Topics of discussion included transportation and infrastructure issues, changing traffic and truck patterns, traffic safety initiatives, and installation of a concrete wall in the Westville/West Grove area.

**Summary of Discussion**


Ten residents attended the Public Information Center to review plans displays and information for a proposed concrete fence along I-295 in Gloucester and Camden Counties. NJDOT staff and other members of the study team were on hand to answer questions and comments from the attendees. A summary of comments received during the meeting follows.

A majority of the residents who attended the meeting were from the Westville portion of the project area. Many of these residents indicated they had questions regarding the proposed concrete fence that would be constructed along the I-295 on-ramp and off-ramp near Delsea Drive (NJ Route 47), and a small portion of I-295. Typical questions related to the type of material the fence would be composed, as well as the overall length and height of the fence. Many residents inquired if the fence length and height could be extended or increased.

Residents were also asked to provide input on the color of the concrete fence. A San Diego Buff (tan) color was chosen following review of the manufacturer's color palette which is consistent with the corridor features.

The meeting ended at 7 p.m.
