This is in response to your application received on June 4, 2020 concerning a previously issued Flood Hazard Area Individual Permit (#0000-14-0021.1 FHA140001), Freshwater Wetlands General Permit 10A (#0000-14-0021.1 FWW140002) and Freshwater Wetlands General Permit 2 (#0000-14-0021.1 FWW140001) to conduct regulated activities within riparian zone and floodway, and to disturb freshwater wetlands and transition areas associated with an unnamed tributary to Ten Mile Run. This all pertaining to a culvert reconstruction, road widening, and relocation of utility crossings, as shown on the approved drawings with the said permits, along Rt. 27 in Franklin Township, Somerset County, New Jersey and South Brunswick, Middlesex County, New Jersey.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:13-22.3 and N.J.A.C. 7:7A-20.4, the permits are hereby extended for five (5) years. All conditions of the original permits shall remain effective, and the permits will now expire on June 17, 2025.
