


## CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL

Notice is hereby given that the Delaware and Raritan Canal Commission issues this Certificate of Approval to the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) for the project known as DRCC# 18-5103B Alexander Road Over D&R Canal Bridge Replacement -- Structure No. 3000-155 located within the Municipalities of West Windsor Township/ Mercer County and Princeton/Mercer County.

This Certificate of Approval shall be effective immediately, conditioned upon compliance with the following items, numbered 1 through 9:

1. State Register review by the State Historic Preservation Office for compliance with the "New Jersey Register of Historic Places Act."
2. The applicant shall obtain New Jersey Water Supply Authority (NJWSA) approval for final designs for:
  - a. Sheeting placement;
  - b. Cofferdam placement and/or by-pass piping/flow capacity;
  - c. Backup plans for the continuous flow of water past the construction site; and
  - d. All work conducted in or under the canal.
3. The Delaware and Raritan Canal is used as a raw water source for several water companies downstream, and as such, water quality and flow shall be maintained.

4. If work in the canal is required, the NJDOT shall following any recommendation by the NJSWA that such work shall be conducted during times of low flow through the canal.
5. During the work, the contractor shall ensure that no debris, soil or vegetation from the work shall fall, drop, be placed or dumped in the canal. The applicant shall ensure that a boom or other method is employed to contain any debris in the canal and remove any debris from the water.
6. It shall be the contractor's responsibility to ensure that all debris caused by the work is removed from the canal.
7. The contractor shall not pierce or puncture the clay liner or the bed of the canal. All work shall be limited to that necessary to construct the proposed improvements and shown on the approved plans. Where the clay liner is compromised or requires removal, the contractor shall record the composition and thickness of the liner and repair or replace the area disturbed to the satisfaction of the NJWSA.
8. The NJDOT shall periodically inform and update the NJSWA on the status of the work schedule for the project.
9. Access to the canal, towpath and adjacent NJSWA buildings for NJWSA personnel shall be maintained.
