I-80 eastbound daytime lane closures during the week needed for retaining wall repairs in Knowlton Expect possible congestion during the morning commute

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the continuation of daytime lane closure of the right lane on I-80 eastbound before the S-curve for retaining wall repairs in Knowlton.

From 9 a.m. until 3 p.m. Monday through Friday for the next two months, NJDOT's contractor IEW Construction Inc., will be closing the right lane on I-80 eastbound just before the S-curve near mile post 1.0 through mile post 1.4. One lane will remain open during construction. The work is necessary to repair the retaining wall and parapet.

Last year a section of damaged pipe under I-80, unrelated to the erosion at the base of the retaining wall, was found and repaired. In addition, the entire drainage system was cleaned and repairs were made to inlets and a drainage outfall.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
