Route 440 northbound ramp to Raritan Center/CR 514 westbound to be closed overnight for bridge repairs in Edison Closure required for bridge deck repairs

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the ramp from Route 440 northbound to Raritan Center/CR 514 westbound will be closed and detoured overnight this week as a bridge repair project advances in Edison, Middlesex County.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Wednesday, May 26 until 7 a.m. tomorrow, Thursday, May 27, and again Thursday during the same hours, NJDOT's contractor, Power Concrete, is scheduled to close the ramp from Route 440 northbound to Raritan Center/CR 514 westbound. This closure will allow the contractor to complete deck repairs on the Route 440 Bridge over CR 514/Woodbridge Avenue. The following singed detour will be in place:

Route 440 northbound ramp to Raritan Center/CR 514 westbound detour:

- Motorists on Route 440 northbound wishing to take the ramp to Raritan Center/CR 514 westbound will be directed to continue on Route 440 northbound
- Take the ramp towards Smith Street/Riverside Drive/Fords
- Keep right at the fork towards Riverside Drive
- Merge onto Riverside Drive
- Turn right onto Parkway Place
- Turn right onto Raritan Center Parkway
- Continue on Raritan Center Parkway, which becomes CR 514/Woodbridge Avenue

The work is part of a \$6.5 million federally-funded project to maintain and repair 36 bridges at various locations throughout Middlesex and Somerset counties.
