Route 9 southbound ramp to Ernston Road/CR 673 westbound closed for emergency sinkhole repairs in Sayreville

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the ramp from Route 9 southbound to Ernston Road/ CR 673 westbound was closed this afternoon for emergency repairs in Sayreville, Middlesex County.

Beginning at approximately 2 p.m. today, Thursday, June 10, the ramp from Route 9 southbound to Ernston Road/CR 673 westbound was closed for emergency sinkhole repairs. The closure is anticipated to continue overnight. The ramp from Route 9 southbound to Ernston Road eastbound/CR673 will remain open.
