## Route 9 northbound to be closed and detoured tonight for drainage repairs in Lakewood, Ocean County Route 9 southbound will remain open

**(Trenton)** - New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced that Route 9 northbound will be closed and detoured tonight as a stormwater maintenance and repair project advances in Lakewood, Ocean County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Friday, June 11, until 6 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, June 12, NJDOT's contractor, Joseph M. Sanzari, Inc., is scheduled to close Route 9 northbound at Henry Street in Lakewood, Ocean County. This closure will allow the contractor to complete stormwater inspections and repairs. Motorists are advised to follow the signed detour or plan an alternate route.

This project is part of a larger \$6 million state-funded maintenance and drainage repair contract to make improvements in various locations in seven counties throughout New Jersey.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
