Route 138 westbound daytime ramp closures required as drainage improvement project advances in Wall Ramps to and from Allenwood Road will be closed and detoured

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced daytime ramp closures on Route 138 westbound as a drainage improvement developer project advances in Wall, Monmouth County.

Beginning at 9 a.m, Tuesday, June 15 until 3 p.m., and continuing daily Monday through Friday for approximately one week, the developer's contractor, J. Lazewski Excavating Company, is scheduled to close the Route 138 westbound ramp to Allenwood Road southbound, and the ramp from Allenwood Road southbound to Route 138 westbound. These closures will allow the contractor to reconstruct concrete curbs and repave the ramps. Motorists are advised to follow the signed detours or plan alternate routes.

Following the completion of work on the ramps, daytime lane closures will be required on Allenwood Road for final paving.
