Diamond Bridge Road to be closed next week as railroad crossing repairs begin in Hawthorne Necessary safety work will require detour

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the start of a railroad crossing rehabilitation project next week that will require a closure and detour of Diamond Bridge Road in Hawthorne, Passaic County.

Beginning at 7 a.m., Monday, June 21, until 7 a.m., Friday, June 25, Diamond Bridge Road will be closed between Grand Avenue and Royal Avenue to remove the existing railroad crossing and be replaced with new concrete crossings and asphalt approaches. Motorists are advised to follow the signed detour or plan an alternate route.

This federally-funded project is included within NJDOT's railroad grade-crossing safety program which repairs, upgrades, or removes approximately 50 crossings each year, statewide.
