I-295 southbound/Al-Jo's Curve to Route 42 southbound/I-295 southbound to be closed and detoured Thursday night Work postponed due to weather forecast

(Trenton) - New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced **the postponement** of the overnight closure of the I-295 southbound ramp to Route 42 southbound/I-295 southbound and a lane closure on I-295 southbound that was scheduled for tonight in Bellmawr, Camden County.

The work to repair damaged guiderail that was scheduled for tonight is being postponed due to the weather forecast. NJDOT will provide public notice once the work is rescheduled. In addition, portable variable message signs are being utilized to provide advance notification to the public of all traffic pattern changes associated with the project.

The work is part of the Direct Connection project that will provide a seamless route for I-295 motorists traveling through the interchange of I-295, I-76, and Route 42. To sign up for I-295 Direct Connect project updates go to 295DirectConnect.com or text CONNECT to 1-844-844-3681.
