Route 36 southbound overnight lane closures this week for pavement repairs in Eatontown, Monmouth County Expect congestion or plan alternate route

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced overnight lane closures on Route 36 southbound this week for permanent pavement repairs in Eatontown and West Long Branch, Monmouth County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Tuesday, July 6 until 5 a.m. the next day and continuing each night on Wednesday, July 7 and Thursday, July 8, both lanes on Route 36 southbound will be closed with traffic shifted to the shoulder to make pavement repairs between Route 71 and Route 35 in Eatontown and West Long Branch. One lane of traffic will be maintained using the shoulder. Last week, temporary emergency pavement repairs were completed. This work will make permanent repairs to the roadway.

Motorists using Route 36 southbound should expect congestion and may want to consider an alternate route.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
