I-295 southbound lane and ramp closures at Exit 34/Route 70 required for emergency bridge repairs in Cherry Hill Closures will continue through the evening commute

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane and ramp closures on I-295 southbound and the Exit 34/Route 70 interchange for emergency bridge repairs in Cherry Hill, Burlington County.

Beginning at approximately 9 a.m. this morning, NJDOT's contractor, I.E.W. Construction Group, closed the entrance ramp from Route 70 westbound to I-295 southbound. The two right lanes on I-295 southbound also were closed near Exit 34. These closures will allow the contractor to replace damaged expansion joints on the bridge carrying I-295 southbound over Route 70.

At least one lane of I-295 southbound traffic will be maintained. The closures are anticipated to continue through the evening commute. Motorists are advised to follow the signed detours and to expect delays.
