I-287 southbound Exit 58 to Route 202 to be closed Monday for retaining wall repairs in Oakland, Bergen County **Right lane on ramp will remain closed for two months**

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced I-287 southbound Exit 58 to Route 202 will be closed and detoured Monday for retaining wall repairs in Oakland, Bergen County.

Beginning at approximately 9 a.m. Monday, August 16 until 3 p.m., NJDOT's contractor, I.E.W. Construction Group, is scheduled to close and detour I-287 southbound Exit 58 to Route 202. This will allow the contractor to install construction barrier along the ramp, creating a work zone to repair a nearby retaining wall. The following signed detour will be in place:

I-287 southbound Exit 58 to Route 202 detour:

- Motorists traveling on I-287 southbound wishing to take Exit 58 to Route 202 will be directed to keep right and continue on I-287 southbound
- Take Exit 57 – Skyline Drive/Ringwood
- Keep left at the fork towards Pompton Lakes
- Turn left onto Skyline Drive, which becomes West Oakland Avenue, and keep right
- Turn right onto the ramp to I-287 northbound
- Merge onto I-287 northbound and keep right
- Take Exit 58 – Route 202/Oakland
- Turn left onto West Oakland Avenue back to Route 202

By 3 p.m. Monday, August 16, the ramp will reopen. The right lane will remain closed for approximately two months as repair work continues.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
