Route 184/Pfeiffer Boulevard eastbound ramp to Route 440 northbound to close this weekend for sinkhole repairs in Woodbridge Signed detour will be in place through Sunday morning

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the ramp from Route 184 eastbound to Route 440 northbound (towards the Outerbridge Crossing/Staten Island) will be closed and detoured this weekend for priority sinkhole repairs in Woodbridge, Middlesex County.

Beginning at 8 p.m., tonight, Friday, August 20, until 6 a.m. Sunday, August 22, NJDOT's contractor is scheduled to close the ramp from Route 184 eastbound to Route 440 southbound. This closure will allow the contractor to complete sinkhole repairs. The following signed detour will be in place:

Route 184/Pfeiffer Boulevard eastbound ramp to Route 440 northbound detour:

- Motorists traveling on Route 184/Pfeiffer Boulevard eastbound wishing to take the ramp to Route 440 southbound will be directed to keep left and merge onto Route 440 southbound
- Take the ramp to New Brunswick Avenue/CR 616
- Turn left onto New Brunswick Avenue/CR 616
- Turn right onto South Florida Road/CR 655
- Turn right onto the ramp to Route 440 northbound

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
