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## Route 46 overnight lane closures required as resurfacing project begins in Hasbrouck Heights, Bergen County Closures required to install construction barrier

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced overnight lane closures on Route 46 in both directions as the Route 46, Bergen Boulevard to Main Street roadway improvement project begins in Hasbrouck Heights, Bergen County.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tomorrow, Saturday, August 28 until 7 a.m. Sunday, August 29, NJDOT's contractor, Joseph M. Sanzari, Inc., is scheduled to close the left lanes on Route 46 in both directions between Bergen Boulevard and Terrace Avenue in Hasbrouck Heights, Bergen County. These closures will allow the contractor to install construction barrier in the shoulder, creating a work zone to reconstruct the existing median barrier. At least one lane of traffic will be maintained in both directions at all times.

The \$8.8 million federally-funded Route 46, Bergen Boulevard to Main Street roadway improvement project will resurface approximately two miles of Route 46 in Lodi, Hasbrouck Heights, and Teterboro, Bergen County. The project also includes the installation of ADA-compliant curbs and ramps, as well as traffic signal upgrades. The project is anticipated to be complete in summer 2022.

Variable Message Signs will be used to provide advance notification to motorists. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
