## How Lane/CR 680 to have alternating traffic tonight for emergency bridge repair over Amtrak in New Brunswick Expect congestion and delays during evening commute

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced How Lane/CR 680 will have alternating traffic between Livingston Avenue/Route 26 and Jersey Avenue/Route 91 in New Brunswick for emergency bridge deck repairs.

At approximately 4 p.m. today, Wednesday, October 6, How Lane/CR 680 westbound will be closed with alternating traffic using the eastbound lane between Livingston Avenue/Route 26 Jersey Avenue/Route 91 in North Brunswick for emergency repairs to the bridge deck over Amtrak. **Motorists should expect congestion and delays during the evening commute.** Repairs are expected to be completed overnight with all lanes reopened by the morning commute.
