## I-287 northbound lane closures for emergency concrete repair in Morristown Expect congestion and heavy delays during evening commute

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane closures on I-287 northbound this evening in Morristown for emergency roadway repairs.

At approximately 5 p.m. today, Thursday, October 7, the left three lanes on I-287 northbound just past Morris Avenue in Morristown will be closed for emergency concrete and joint repairs to the roadway. One lane will be maintained. Repairs are expected to be completed overnight with all lanes reopened by the morning commute.

Motorists should expect heavy congestion and delays during the evening commute, and may want to consider alternate routes.
