I-78 westbound lane closure needed for shoulder work near Bridge over Raritan River in Bedminster, Somerset County Daytime closure needed to install rumble strips

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced a daytime lane closure tomorrow on I-78 westbound before the Bridge over the North Branch of the Raritan River for shoulder work in Bedminster, Somerset County.

Beginning at 10 a.m., Friday, November 5, until 2 p.m., the right lane on I-78 westbound is scheduled to be closed between I-287 and Exit 26/Rattlesnake Bridge Road in order to install rumble strips on the edge line of the right shoulder. At least two lanes will be maintained during construction. In October, the shoulder was widened to improve safety in the construction zone for the replacement of the Bridge over the North Branch of the Raritan River in Bedminster.
