Route 440 northbound right lane closed for emergency pavement repair in Woodbridge Repairs expected to continue through the evening commute

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the right lane on Route 440 northbound toward Staten Island was closed this morning for emergency pavement repairs in Woodbridge, Middlesex County.

Beginning at approximately 11:30 a.m. today, Tuesday, December 7, the right lane on Route 440 northbound, toward Staten Island, was closed before the Smith Street exit in Woodbridge to make emergency pavement repairs. The closure is expected to continue through the evening commute. All ramps and at least two lanes will remain open during construction. The work is expected to be completed before the morning commute tomorrow, Wednesday, December 8.

Motorists are advised to expect delays this evening and to consider alternate routes.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
