I-80 eastbound left and center lanes to be closed for emergency bridge deck repairs this afternoon in Parsippany-Troy Hills **Expect heavy congestion or plan alternate route**

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the left and center lanes on I-80 eastbound will be closed this afternoon for emergency bridge repairs in Parsippany-Troy Hills, Morris County.

Beginning at approximately 3:30 p.m. today, Thursday, December 9, the left and center lanes on I-80 eastbound will be closed after Exit 47B/Route 46 for emergency repairs to the Bridge over the Rockaway River in Parsippany-Troy Hills. At least one lane will remain open during construction. This closure will allow NJDOT's contractor, Mount Construction, to remove loose concrete and reconstruct a portion of the bridge deck. The lane closures are expected to continue through late tonight.

Motorists using I-80 eastbound for the evening commute should expect heavy congestion and may want to consider using Route 46 as an alternate route.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
