## Route 440 southbound overnight lane closures Monday for sign structure installation in Perth Amboy Temporary traffic stoppages necessary

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced overnight lane closures of Route 440 southbound on Monday, December 20 as an overhead sign structure replacement project advances in Perth Amboy, Middlesex County.

Beginning at 11 p.m. Monday, December 20 until 5 a.m. Tuesday, December 21, NJDOT's contractor, J. Fletcher Creamer & Son, Inc., is scheduled to close the right lane on Route 440 southbound (from Staten Island) starting at the toll plaza in Staten Island through Amboy Avenue in Perth Amboy. After midnight, there will be a few temporary 15-minute stoppages of traffic to remove the existing sign structure and install the new sign structure before the pedestrian bridge over Route 440. New Jersey State Police will assist with the traffic stoppages.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
