## I-76 lanes closed for emergency repairs to the median in Gloucester City Repairs expected to be completed tonight

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced that the left lane on I-76 in both directions is closed for emergency repairs to the median in Gloucester City, Camden County.

Around 9 a.m., this morning, Thursday, January 20, there was a crash that damaged the concrete median on I-76 near mile post 1.7. The incident has been cleared and the left lane in each direction will remain closed to allow NJDOT's contractor, IEW Construction Group, to make repairs to the median. The work is expected to be completed tonight after the evening commute. Motorists should use caution, slow down, and move over to give crews room to work safely.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
