## Route 440 southbound overnight lane closures Saturday for restriping in Perth Amboy At least one lane will be maintained during the work

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced overnight lane closures of Route 440 southbound on Saturday, February 12 for restriping in Perth Amboy, Middlesex County.

Beginning at 10 p.m. Saturday, February 12 until 8 a.m. Sunday, February 13, NJDOT's contractor, J. Fletcher Creamer & Son, Inc., is scheduled to close the right lane on Route 440 southbound (from Staten Island) starting at the toll plaza in Staten Island through Amboy Avenue in Perth Amboy. Upon completion of work on the right lane, the left lane will be closed for restriping. At least one lane will be maintained overnight. The restriping is part of a project that replaced an overhead sign structure in December.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
