Route 206 temporary lane closures next week as pavement repair project begins in Mercer and Somerset Counties Work to start with curb and inlet repairs

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the start of a project to repair pavement on Route 206, Route 1 and Route 1 Business in Somerset and Mercer Counties.

Beginning at 9 a.m. Monday, February 28 until 3 p.m. and continuing Monday through Friday, NJDOT's Contractor, Schifano Construction Corp, is scheduled to temporary close one lane of traffic on Route 206 between approximately Arreton Road in Princeton, Mercer County and Sycamore Lane in Montgomery, Somerset County for inlet repairs and concrete curb work. Later this year, the roadway will be milled and paved.

The \$9.5 million project is designed to extend the pavement life, improve safety, and enhance ride quality for motorists on three highways:

- Route 206 from approximately Arreton Road in Princeton, Mercer County to Sycamore Lane in Montgomery, Somerset County
- Route 1 from Emmons Drive to approximately Varisty Drive in West Windsor, Mercer County
- Route 1 Business from Lake Drive to where Route 1 Business rejoins Route 1 near Carnegie Road in Lawrence, Mercer County.

The project is scheduled to be completed in the fall of 2022.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
