## Route 18 northbound ramp to Easton Avenue closed for emergency sinkhole repair in New Brunswick, Middlesex County Separate car and truck detours in place

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the Route 18 northbound exit ramp to Easton Avenue is closed and detoured for an emergency sinkhole in New Brunswick, Middlesex County.

At approximately 4 p.m. today, Wednesday, March 23, the Route 18 northbound ramp to Easton Avenue was closed and detoured to repair a sinkhole. The ramp will remain closed until further notice. The following car and truck detours are in place:

## **Route 18 northbound ramp to Easton Avenue Car Detour:**

- Cars on Route 18 northbound wishing to take the ramp to Easton Avenue will be directed to continue on Route 18 northbound
- Cross the river and take the first exit for River Road
- Stay right to merge onto River Road/CR 622 northbound
- Turn left onto Landing Lane
- Cross the river and follow Landing Lane back to Easton Avenue

## **Route 18 northbound ramp to Easton Avenue Truck Detour:**

- Trucks on Route 18 northbound wishing to take the ramp to Easton Avenue will be directed to continue on Route 18 northbound
- Cross the river and take the first exit for River Road
- Stay right to merge onto River Road/CR 622 northbound
- Take River Road/CR 622 northbound to I-287 northbound
- Cross the river and take Exit 10 to Easton Avenue

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
