I-80 eastbound on-ramp from Landing Road southbound to be closed tonight for bridge work in Roxbury Closures required for deck repairs

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced that the I-80 eastbound on-ramp from Landing Road southbound will be closed tonight for bridge work in Roxbury, Morris County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Friday, April 29, until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, April 30, NJDOT's contractor, Mount Construction, is scheduled to close and detour the ramp from Landing Road southbound to I-80 eastbound. The closure is necessary to make concrete repairs to the bridge deck over Ledgewood Road. The following detour will be in place:

Landing Road southbound to I-80 eastbound ramp detour:

- Motorists on Landing Road southbound wishing to take the ramp to I-80 eastbound will be directed to continue on Landing Road southbound, which becomes Route 46
- Take the jughandle to make a U-Turn/to I-80
- Turn left onto Route 46 northbound, which becomes Ledgewood Road
- Take the ramp to I-80 eastbound

The work is part of a \$21.6 million state-funded maintenance project to repair concrete structures at various locations in eight counties throughout North Jersey.
