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Route 9 northbound ramps to and from Main Street in Woodbridge to be closed overnight this week

Closures and detours necessary for water main work

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the Route 9 northbound ramps to and from Main Street/CR 514 will be closed this week for water main work in Woodbridge, Middlesex County.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Monday, May 16, until 5 a.m. Tuesday, May 17, and continuing nightly through Friday, May 20, Middlesex Water Company's contractor, J.F. Kiely Construction Co., is scheduled to close and detour the Main Street/CR 514 ramps to and from Route 9 northbound. The closure is necessary for water main installation. The following detours will be in place:

Main Street/CR 514 ramp to Route 9 northbound detour:

- Motorists on Main Street/CR 514 wishing to take the ramp to Route 9 northbound will be directed to continue on Main Street/CR 514
- Turn left onto Route 35/Amboy Avenue
- Turn left onto Green Street/CR 604, which become Route 9 northbound

Route 9 northbound ramp to Main Street/CR 514 detour:

- Motorists on Route 9 northbound wishing to take the ramp to Main Street/CR 514 will be directed to continue on Route 9 northbound
- Take the ramp to CR 604 East/Green Street
- Turn right onto Green Street/CR 604
- Turn right onto Route 35/Amboy Avenue back to Main Street/CR 514
