Route 22 lane and shoulder closure this week for guiderail installation in Union Township Closures necessary as part of developer project

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane and shoulder closures on Route 22 eastbound for guiderail installation in Union Township, Union County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Friday, May 20, J. A. Neary Excavating is scheduled to close the right lane and shoulder on Route 22 eastbound just before the Vauxhall Road overpass to install concrete barrier. The shoulder closure is necessary for the installation of a new guiderail as part of a developer project and is expected to last approximately one week. The closures are not expected to impact traffic.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
