## Route 1 northbound right lanes and on-ramp from Grandview Avenue eastbound will be closed tonight in Edison Closures necessary for maintenance stormwater repairs

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced a lane and partial ramp closure on Route 1 northbound tonight for maintenance stormwater repairs in Edison, Middlesex County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Wednesday, May 25, until 6 a.m. Thursday, May 26, NJDOT's contractor, IEW Construction Group, is scheduled to close two right lanes on Route 1 northbound just before Grandview Avenue for stormwater repairs. In addition, part of the ramp from Grandview Avenue eastbound to Route 1 northbound will be closed. These closures are not expected to impact traffic.

The work is part of a \$6.1 million state-funded maintenance contract to repair stormwater facilities and manholes at various locations in seven counties throughout Central Jersey. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
