I-295 southbound Exit 60A to be closed and detoured overnight tonight and tomorrow night in Hamilton Closures necessary for electrical work

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the I-295 southbound Exit 60A ramp to I-195 eastbound/Belmar/NJ Turnpike/I-95 will be closed and detoured overnight tonight and tomorrow tonight for re-lamping and electrical work in Hamilton, Mercer County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Wednesday, May 25, until 5 a.m., tomorrow, Thursday, May 26, and again from 9 p.m. Thursday, May 26 until 5 a.m. Friday, May 27, NJDOT's contractor, Orchard Holdings, is scheduled to close and detour the I-295 southbound ramp at Exit 60A to I-195 eastbound/Belmar/NJ Turnpike/I-95. The following detour will be in place:

I-295 southbound Exit 60A detour:

- Motorists traveling on I-295 southbound wishing to take Exit 60A to I-195 eastbound/Belmar/NJ Turnpike/I-95 will be directed to continue on I-295 southbound
- Take Exit 57A/Route 130 northbound/Bordentown
- Take the first exit onto I-295 northbound/Trenton
- Take Exit 60 to I-195 eastbound/Trenton/Belmar/NJ Turnpike/I-95

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
