Route 322 lane closures this week for guiderail installation in Gloucester County Closures necessary as part of developer project

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane and shoulder closures on Route 322 westbound tonight to clear trees in Logan Township, Gloucester County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Tuesday, May 31, until 6 a.m., Wednesday, June 1, and continuing nightly for approximately two weeks, Allan Meyers, Inc. is scheduled to close Route 322 westbound just past the Route 322 and Stone Meetinghouse Road/Berkeley Drive intersection. The lane closure is necessary for clearing trees as part of a developer project and is expected to last approximately two weeks. An alternating traffic pattern will be used to maintain traffic.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
