Route 179 overnight lane closures for pavement project in Hunterdon County

Alternating traffic to be maintained during closures

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced overnight lane closures on Route 179 tonight with alternating traffic as a pavement preservation project begins in Lambertville, Hunterdon County.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Tuesday, May 31, until 6 a.m., Wednesday, June 1, and continuing nightly Monday through Friday, NJDOT's contractor, Asphalt Paving Systems, Inc., is scheduled to close a single lane on Route 179 between the intersection where Bridge Street meets Route 29 and Route 202 near the Speedway Gas Station. Alternating traffic will be maintained during construction. The closures are expected to last for approximately two months and are necessary for slurry sealing.

The \$2.6 million federally-funded project will preserve approximately seven miles of pavement on Route 179 from Route 29 to Route 202 in Lambertville, Hunterdon County. The project is expected to be completed in summer 2022.
