Route 47 lane closures begin tomorrow for culvert and sidewalk repairs in Millville, Cumberland County Detours will be in place during construction

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced Route 47 will be closed in both directions for a culvert and sidewalk repair project in Millville City, Cumberland County.

Beginning at 9 a.m. tomorrow, Wednesday, June 1, until 3 p.m. and continuing daily, Monday through Friday, NJDOT's contractor, Mount Construction Co., is scheduled to close Route 47 in both directions to repair the culvert and sidewalk on Route 47 northbound between Kates Boulevard and Mayline Street. The following detours will be in place daily Monday through Friday for approximately three months:

Route 47 northbound detour:

- Motorists on Route 47 northbound will be directed to turn right onto Kates Boulevard
- Turn left onto South 3rd Street
- Turn left onto Maylin Street
- Turn right onto Route 47

Route 47 southbound detour:

- Motorists on Route 47 northbound will be directed to turn left onto Mayline Street
- Turn right onto South 3rd Street
- Turn right onto Kates Boulevard
- Turn left onto Route 47

Variable messaging signs are being utilized to provide advance notification to the motoring public of all traffic pattern changes associated with the work. NJDOT will provide more information before any lane closures are scheduled.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
