I-195 eastbound right lane closed at Exit 3 in Hamilton for emergency debris removal Lane closure may impact evening rush hour commute

Lane closure may impact evening rush nour commute

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials advise motorists of possible significant delays on I-195 eastbound at Exit 3/Hamilton Square-Yardville Road due to emergency debris removal in Hamilton, Mercer County.

All I-195 eastbound lanes at Exit 3 in Hamilton were closed earlier Thursday morning following an overturned tractor trailer incident which caused metal debris to be spilled on the roadway. NJDOT crews and the New Jersey State Police are working to clean up the roadway and will remain onsite until the debris has been cleared. One lane has been opened so far and the cleanup efforts are expected to be completed later this evening. If work is completed early, the lane will reopen sooner.

Motorists are advised to avoid the area or find an alternate route.
