Route 130 and I-295 interchange ramp closures tonight and Friday night in Bordentown, Burlington County Closures necessary for milling and paving work

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced ramp closures tonight and Friday night at the Route 130 and I-295 interchange in Bordentown, Burlington County.

Tonight, Thursday, June 9

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Thursday, June 9 until 6 a.m. tomorrow, Friday, June 10, NJDOT's contractor, South State, Inc., is scheduled to close the I-295 southbound ramp to Route 130 northbound and the Route 130 southbound ramp to I-295 southbound for milling and paving. The following detours will be in effect:

I-295 southbound ramp to Route 130 northbound detour:

- Motorists on I-295 southbound wishing to take Exit 57A to Route 130 North/Bordentown will be directed to take Exit 57B to Route 130 South/Burlington, which is before Exit 57A
- Merge onto Route 130 southbound
- Take the Dunns Mill Road U-turn
- Turn left onto Route 130 northbound

Route 130 southbound ramp to I-295 southbound:

- Motorists on Route 130 southbound wishing to take the ramp to I-295 southbound will be directed to continue on Route 130 southbound
- Take the Dunns Mill Road U-turn
- Continue straight on Dunns Mills Road
- Turn right onto Route 206 southbound
- Turn right onto the connector road to Rising Sun Road/I-295
- Turn right onto Rising Sun Road
- Turn right onto the ramp to I-295 southbound

Tomorrow, Friday, June 10

Beginning at 8 p.m. tomorrow, Friday, June 10, until 6 a.m. Saturday, June 11, scheduled to close the I-295 southbound ramp to Route 130 southbound and the Route 130 northbound ramp to I-295 northbound are scheduled to be closed for milling and paving. The following detours will be in effect:

I-295 southbound ramp to Route 130 southbound detour:

- Motorists on I-295 southbound wishing to take the ramp to Route 130 southbound will be directed to continue on I-295 southbound
- Take Exit 57A to Route 130 northbound/Bordentown

- Turn right onto Crosswicks Road/CR 528
- Turn right to West CR 528/Bordentown/Bordentown City Historic District
- Turn right onto Route 130 southbound/Route 206 southbound
- Stay left to continue on Route 130 southbound

Route 130 northbound ramp to I-295 northbound detour:

- Motorist on Route 130 northbound wishing to take the ramp to I-295 northbound will be directed to continue on Route 130 northbound
- Turn right onto Crosswicks Road/CR 528
- Stay right to take the ramp to CR 528 West/Bordentown/Bordentown City Historic District
- Turn left onto Route 130 southbound/Route 206 southbound
- Stay right to continue on Route 130 southbound
- Take the ramp to I-295 northbound/Trenton

This work is part of a \$7.2 million state-funded maintenance project to make roadway repairs in Burlington, Camden, and Gloucester counties. The project is expected to be completed this summer.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
