I-80 eastbound lane and ramp closures at Exit 34 to Route 15 tonight in Wharton, Morris County Closures necessary for concrete work

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane and ramp closures on I-80 eastbound at the Exit 34 ramp to Route 15 tonight for concrete deck repair.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Friday, June 24, until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, June 25, NJDOT's contractor, Mount Construction, Co., is scheduled to close and detour the I-80 eastbound Exit 34 ramp to Route 15 to repair concrete on the bridge deck. The center and right lanes on I-80 eastbound also will be closed just before the ramp and continue for about a half mile. The left lane will remain open. The following detour will be in place:

I-80 eastbound Exit 34 to Route 15 detour:

- Motorists on I-80 eastbound wishing to take Exit 34 to Route 15 will be directed to continue on I-80 eastbound
- Take Exit 35/Mount Hope/Dover
- Stay left on the ramp
- Turn left onto Route 661/Mt. Hope Avenue
- Turn left to take the ramp to I-80 westbound
- Take Exit 34A to Route 15 southbound or take Exit 34B to Route 15 northbound

The work is part of a \$21.6 million state-funded maintenance project to repair concrete structures at various locations in eight counties throughout North Jersey.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
