NJ Turnpike ramp to Route 1&9 Truck northbound to be closed for two nights for Passaic River Bridge work between Kearny & Newark Traffic to be detoured using Raymond Avenue

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced that the New Jersey Turnpike ramp to Route 1&9 Truck northbound and the right lane on Route 1&9 Truck northbound will be closed tonight and tomorrow night for maintenance work on the bridge across the Passaic River.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Monday, July 11 until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Tuesday, July 12, and again from 8 p.m. tomorrow, Tuesday, July 12, until 5 a.m., Wednesday, July 13, NJDOT's contractor IEW Construction, will close the ramp from the New Jersey Turnpike to Route 1&9 Truck northbound and close the right lane on Route 1&9 Truck northbound for maintenance work on the Bridge over the Passaic River. The following detour will be in place:

New Jersey Turnpike Exit 15 to Route 1&9 Truck northbound in Newark:

- Stay right when leaving the NJTA Exit 15 Toll booth and take the first right exit ramp to Doremus Avenue
- At the traffic light, turn left onto Doremus Avenue north
- Stay right and follow signs for Route 1&9 Truck South/Raymond Boulevard
- Stay right and take the exit for Raymond Boulevard
- Stay left after going under the Turnpike
- At traffic light turn left onto Raymond Boulevard, which becomes Route 1&9 Truck northbound
