I-80 eastbound lane closures tonight for expansion joint repairs in Parsippany-Troy Hills Repairs made just before Exit 43 to I-287

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane closures on I-80 eastbound tonight just past the Exit 43 ramp to I-287 for expansion joint repairs in Parsippany-Troy Hills, Morris County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Friday, August 12, until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, August 13, NJDOT contractor, IEW Construction, is scheduled to close three of five lanes on I-80 eastbound just past the Exit 43 ramp to I-287. The lane closures are necessary to replace an expansion joint that buckled on Wednesday, July 20. Motorists are advised to slow down or move over in the work zone if possible.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
