Route 29 northbound lane closures tonight as drainage improvement project continues in Trenton Closures necessary for striping

(Trenton) – Two lanes on Route 29 northbound will be closed tonight, Friday, September 16, at 9 p.m. until 7 a.m. Saturday, September 17, for striping between Cass Street/Thunder Road and Calhoun Street in Trenton, Mercer County.

Two lanes of traffic will be maintained during construction. Motorists are advised to slow down, use caution, and expect delays, while driving through the work zone, or plan an alternate route.

This work is part of the \$29.1 million federally-funded Route 29, Cass Street to Calhoun Street Drainage project in Trenton. Work includes drainage improvements, shoulder widening, new inlets, and the construction of a new flood wall. These drainage improvements will prevent backwater from the Delaware River from flooding Route 29, and the new flood wall will provide protection from river erosion. The project is expected to be completed in the fall 2025.
