Route 17 ramps to Route 46 eastbound to be closed and detoured tonight and tomorrow night in Teterboro Route 46 eastbound ramp to Green Street also closed for two nights

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the Route 17 ramps to Route 46 eastbound will be closed and detoured tonight for guiderail work in Teterboro, Bergen County. This is a continuation of work that began on Monday night.

Beginning at 10 p.m. tonight, Wednesday, September 28, until 6 a.m. tomorrow, Thursday, September 29, NJDOT's contractor, Joseph M. Sanzari, Inc., is scheduled to close and detour the Route 17 northbound and southbound ramps to Route 46 eastbound. In addition, the Route 46 eastbound ramp to Green Street will be closed and detoured tonight at the same time. The closures are necessary for guiderail work. Motorists are advised to follow the posted detour signs.

The \$8.8 million federally-funded Route 46, Bergen Boulevard to Main Street roadway improvement project will resurface approximately two miles of Route 46 in Lodi, Hasbrouck Heights, and Teterboro, Bergen County. The project also includes the installation of ADA-compliant curbs and ramps, as well as traffic signal upgrades. The project is expected to be complete in summer 2022.
