Route 33 westbound ramp to West Main Street/CR 537 westbound to be closed and detoured tonight in Freehold, Monmouth County Closure necessary for electrical work

(Trenton) – The Route 33 westbound ramp to West Main Street/CR 537 westbound will be closed and detoured tonight, Thursday, October 20, from 8 p.m. to 4 a.m. Friday, October 21, in Freehold, Monmouth County. The closure is necessary for electrical work. The following detour will be in place:

Route 33 westbound to West Main Street/CR 537 detour:

- Motorists on Route 33 westbound wishing to take the ramp to CR 537 westbound/Smithburg will be directed to take the ramp to CR 537 eastbound to Route 9 northbound
- Stay right to take the jughandle/U-Turn to the Freehold Raceway Mall
- Turn left onto West Main Street/CR 537

The work is part of the \$1.5 million state-funded Relamping South project that will upgrade traffic signals at various locations throughout Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, Cumberland, Gloucester, Mercer, Monmouth, Ocean and Salem counties.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
