Route 208 lane closures tonight as culvert replacement project begins in Wycoff, Bergen County One lane will be maintained overnight

(Trenton) – The right lane on Route 208 northbound and southbound will be closed from 8 p.m. tonight, Friday, October 21 until 7 a.m. Saturday, October 22 in Wycoff, Bergen County.

The closures are necessary to install construction barriers and create a work zone in the right shoulders, between the exits for Russell Avenue and Cedar Hill Avenue. Work will begin on the southbound side. Once complete, work will move to the northbound side. One lane will be maintained overnight and both lanes will reopen on Saturday morning.

The \$3.9 million federally-funded project will replace the existing culverts on Route 208 northbound and southbound between mile post 6.2 and 6.4. The project also includes guiderail replacement. Work is expected to be complete in the summer of 2025.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
