Jones Road southbound daytime closures next week for utility work in Englewood, Bergen County Alternating traffic will be maintained during construction

(Trenton) – Jones Road southbound will be closed between Ridgeland Terrace and Walton Street from 9 a.m. Monday, October 24, until 3 p.m. for the start of a bridge replacement project in Englewood, Bergen County.

In addition, Jones Road southbound is scheduled to be closed daily Tuesday, October 25, through Friday, October 28, at the same time. The closure is necessary for utility work. Alternating traffic will be maintained on Jones Road northbound. Motorists are advised to slow down, use caution, and expect delays while driving through the work zone, or plan an alternate route.

The \$20.7 million federally-funded project will replace the Jones Road Bridge over Route 4 in Englewood Bergen County. The new bridge will be approximately three feet higher to improve under-clearance issues on Route 4. Work is expected to be complete in the summer of 2025.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
