## Route 49 and CR 667/Harmersville-Pecks Corner Road lane and shoulder closures for two nights in Quinton, Salem County Alternating traffic will be maintained overnight

**(Trenton)** – One lane on CR 667/Harmersville-Peck Corner Road is scheduled to be closed tonight and tomorrow night in Quinton, Salem County. In addition, the right shoulder on Route 49 eastbound will be closed between CR 667/Harmersville-Pecks Corner Road and Gravelly Hill Road.

Starting at 8 p.m. tonight, Tuesday, December 13, until 6 a.m. Wednesday, December 14, and again on Wednesday night at the same times, one lane on CR 667/Harmersville-Pecks Corner Road is scheduled to be closed between Route 49/Quinton-Marlboro Road and CR 626/Jericho Road for milling and paving work. Alternating traffic will be maintained on CR 667/Harmersville-Peck Corner Road on both nights. In addition, the right shoulder on Route 49 eastbound will be closed between CR 667/Harmersville-Pecks Corner Road and Gravelly Hill Road.

This work is part of a \$7.2 million state-funded project that will improve drainage and pavement conditions on Route 30 in Atlantic County and various other locations in Atlantic, Cape May, Cumberland, and Salem counties.
