I-295 northbound lane closures for several nights in Bellmawr, Camden County

Closures necessary for Browning Road Bridge abutment demolition

(Trenton) - New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane closures on I-295 northbound tonight and continuing next week as the Direct Connection project advances in Bellmawr, Camden County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Tuesday, February 28, until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Wednesday, March 1, and continuing Monday through Friday nights at the same time, through Friday, March 10, the right lane on I-295 northbound at Exit 26 where the highway splits for I-76 toward Philadelphia and I-295 toward Trenton is scheduled to be closed. In addition, the auxiliary lane from Route 42 northbound onto I-295 northbound also will be closed. At least one lane will be maintained overnight. The closure is necessary for demolition of the east abutment of the Browning Road Bridge. Motorists should expect congestion on I-295 northbound.

The work is part of the Direct Connection and Missing Moves project that will provide a seamless route for I-295 motorists traveling through the interchange of I-295, I-76, and Route 42.
