I-280 eastbound Exit 6 ramp to Laurel Avenue to be closed Monday morning in Livingston, Essex County Closure expected to remain in place over the next several weeks

(Trenton) – The I-280 eastbound Exit 6 ramp to Laurel Avenue is scheduled to be closed at 9 a.m. Monday, May 1 in Livingston, Essex County. The ramp closure is expected to remain in place for approximately six weeks and is necessary for drainage repairs. The following detour will be in place:

I-280 eastbound Exit 6 to Laurel Avenue detour:

- Motorists on I-280 eastbound wishing to take Exit 6 to Laurel Avenue will be directed to continue on I-280 eastbound
- Take Exit 7 to Pleasant Valley Way/Millburn/Verona
- Turn right onto Pleasant Valley Way
- Go underneath I-280
- Take the ramp to I-280 westbound
- Take Exit 6B to Laurel Avenue northbound Or
- Take Exit 6A to Laurel Avenue southbound

The work is part of a \$15.8 million state-funded maintenance project to repair stormwater facilities at various locations in eight counties throughout North Jersey.
