Route 130 southbound overnight lane closures this week for bridge repairs in Burlington and Mercer counties At least one lane will be maintained

(Trenton) – A single lane on Route 130 southbound is scheduled to be closed overnight this week on the Route 130 Bridge over Crosswicks Creek in Bordentown, Burlington County and Hamilton, Mercer Counties.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Tuesday, May 2, until 6 a.m. tomorrow, Wednesday, May 3, and continuing nightly Wednesday, May 3, and Thursday, May 4, at the same times, a single lane on Route 130 southbound will be closed on the bridge over Crosswicks Creek. Construction is expected to start in the right lane and move to the left lane, as work progresses. The closures are necessary to make bridge joint and concrete repairs. At least one lane will be maintained on Route 130 southbound during construction.

This work is part of the \$8.9 million federally funded bridge preventative maintenance contract that will make joint and concrete repairs to approximately 41 bridges on Routes 40, 47, and 130 in various locations across Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, Cumberland, Gloucester, Mercer and Salem counties.
