I-295 southbound/Al-Jo's Curve to be closed and detoured Tuesday night Overnight closures necessary to repair attenuators

(Trenton) - New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced that the closure of the I-295 southbound ramp to Route 42 southbound and I-295 southbound, also known as Al-Jo's Curve, which was schedule for tonight, **has been postponed due to weather** in Bellmawr, Camden County. NJDOT will provide advanced notice of future closures, once the work has been rescheduled.

The work is part of the Direct Connection project that will provide a seamless route for I-295 motorists traveling through the interchange of I-295, I-76, and Route 42. To sign up for I-295 Direct Connect project updates go to 295DirectConnect.com or text CONNECT to 1-844-844-3681.

Portable variable message signs are being utilized to provide advance notification to the public of all traffic pattern changes associated with the work. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
