Nicholson Road westbound daytime closure and detour required over the next several months in Gloucester City Closure necessary for utility relocation

(Trenton) – Nicholson Road westbound is scheduled to be closed and detoured daily over the next several months between Oxford Avenue and University Avenue in Gloucester City, Camden County.

From 7 a.m. until 5 p.m. Monday, May 8, and continuing daily Monday through Friday at the same times over the next several months, Nicholson Road westbound is scheduled to be closed and detoured underneath I-76. The closure is necessary for utility relocation. The following detour will be in place:

Nicholson Road westbound detour:

- Motorists on Nicholson Road westbound will be directed to Route 130/Crescent Boulevard southbound
- Turn right onto Market Street/CR 634 westbound
- Turn right onto Baynes Avenue
- Turn left onto South Johnson Boulevard, back to Nicholson Road

The \$1.9 million federally funded project will relocate utilities near the I-76 Bridge over Nicholson Road in Gloucester City, Camden County. Construction is expected to be completed in winter 2023. This utility relocation work is in preparation for the larger I-76/I-676 Bridges and Pavement project that is still in design, which will replace the bridge deck and superstructure of the I-76 Bridge over Nicholson Road, as well as rehabilitate and pave the I-76/I-676 northbound and the I-676 southbound bridges over the Main Branch of Newton Creek.
